Daily Capstones

- 1 – *To know and do God's will, you must deny self and return to a God-centered life*
- 2 – *Understanding what God is about to do where I am is more important than telling God what I want to do for Him.*

- 4 – *God has not changed. He still speaks to His people.*

Principles

- We are His servants, and we adjust our lives to what He is about to do.

- If you have trouble hearing God speak, you are in trouble at the heart of your Christian experience.
- Knowing God's voice comes from an intimate love relationship with God.
- The moment God speaks to you is the time He wants you to respond to Him.
- If God has a great task for you, He will expand your character to match that assignment.

PSALMS 20:7

- 1 – I must seek to see from God’s perspective rather than from my own distorted human outlook.
- 1 - I must wait until God shows me what He is about to do through me.
- 1 – I will watch to see what God is doing around me and join Him.
- 2 – Do things God’s way.
- 2 – God will accomplish more in six months through a people yielded to Him than we could do in 60 years without Him.
- 2 – I am God’s servant. I adjust my life to what He is about to do.
- 3 – I come to know God by experience as I obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through me.
- 3 – “I seek at the beginning to get my heart into such a state that it has no will of its own in regard to a given matter. I do not leave the result to feeling or simple impression. I seek the will of the Spirit of God through, or in connection with, the Word of God.”
- 4 – God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways.
- 5 – The moment God speaks to me is God’s timing.
- 5 – God has a right to interrupt my life. He is Lord. When I accepted Him as Lord, I gave Him the right to help Himself to my life anytime He wants.
