Daily Capstones


- 1 – *When God tells me what He wants to do through me, I will face a crisis of belief.*
- 2 – *Faith is confidence that what God has promised or said will come to pass.*
- 3 – *God is interested in the world's coming to know Him.*
- 4 – *What you do reveals what you believe about God, regardless of what you say.*
- 5 – *Faith without action is dead!*

Principles

- The way you live your life is a testimony of what you believe about God.
- Faith is valid only in God and in what He says He is purposing to do.
- Obedience indicates faith in God.
- Our world is not seeing God because we are not attempting anything that only God can do.
- Let the world watch God at work, and He will attract people to Himself.
- God is far more concerned with your walking with Him than He is interested in getting a job done for Him.
- Unbelief was extremely costly.
- God has planned something far better for people of faith than the world has to offer.

SUMMARY & REVIEW

- 1 – When God tells me what He wants to do through me, I will face a crisis of belief.
- 2 – When God speaks, my response requires faith.
- 2– Faith is confidence that what God has promised or said will come to pass.
- 2 – Sight is the opposite of faith. Faith must be in a person.
- 2– Before I call myself, my family, or my church to exercise faith, I must be sure I have heard a word from God.
- 2 – When God lets me know what He wants to do through me, it will be something only He can do.
- 2 & 4– What I believe about God will determine what I do and how I live.
- 3– When God’s people and the world see something only God can do, they come to know God.
- 3 – Let people see the difference a living Christ makes in a life, a family, or a church, that will make a difference in how they respond to the gospel.
- 4 – What I do reveals what I believe about God, regardless of what I say.
- 5 – Faith without action is dead! Genuine faith is demonstrated by action.
- 5 – God has planned something far better for people of faith. Don’t grow weary in being faithful. A reward awaits faithful servants.
