### Principles


---

- Critical Turning Points: 1. Crisis of Belief 2. Major Adjustments
- God's revelation is your invitation to adjust your life to Him.
- Adjusting one's life to God is well worth the cost.
- Any adjustment God expects you to make is for your good.
- "If Jesus Christ be God and died for me, then no sacrifice is too great for me to give for Him." – C.T. Studd
- You cannot know and do God's will without paying the price of adjustment and obedience.
- You can trust God with your family!
- We must learn to trust Christ to communicate with His people.
- *It never works! He works!*
- Only God has the right to tell you what to do.
