Daily Capstones


- 1 – *You come to know God by experience as you obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through you.*
- 2 – *Obedience means joy and uninterrupted fellowship with God.*
- 3 – *You too will be blessed when God does a special God-sized work through you.*
- 4 – *God reveals Himself to His people by what He does.*
- 5 – *God will never give me an assignment He will not enable me to complete.*

Principles

- Realities 1-7: Work / Love Relationship / Invitation / Speaks / Crisis / Adjust / Obey.
- When He gives you a command, you are to obey it.
- God often gives a second chance.
- God is interested in developing your character.
- God is far more interested in accomplishing His kingdom purposes than you are.
- God's desire is for a relationship.

Summary Statements

- 1 – I come to know God by experience as I obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through me.
- 1 – If I love God, I will obey Him. Obedience is the outward expression of my love for God.
- 1 – Faith that does not obey in actions is dead.
- 1 – Obedience is my moment of truth. God blesses those who are obedient to Him.

- Let Him work out the details in His timing.
- Do all you know to do.
- Wait on the Lord until He tells you what to do next.

SUMMARY & REVIEW

- 2 – Obedience is doing what is commanded. I should obey what I already know to be God’s will.
- 2 – When God sees that I am faithful and obedient in a little, He will entrust me with more.
- 2 – God often gives second chances. Sometimes God does not give a second chance.
- 2 – Disobedience is costly. Affirmation comes after obedience.
- 3 – When I obey God, He will accomplish through me what He has purposed to do.
- 3– God wants to reveal Himself to me and to those around me.
- 3 – I will be blessed when God does a special, God-sized work through me.
- 3– I need to be careful that any testimony about what God has done gives glory only to Him. “Let him who boasts boast in the Lord” (I Cor. 1:31).
- 5 – I will allow God to take all the time He needs to shape me for His purposes. Let God work out the details in His timing.
- 5 – Any assignment that comes from the Maker of the universe is an important responsibility.
- 5 – I won’t ignore the relationship and take things into my own hands.
- 5 – I must know the ways of God so thoroughly that if something doesn’t measure up to God’s ways, I will know it is not from Him and will turn away from it.
