Daily Capstones

- 1 – *You cannot be in relationship with Jesus and not be on mission.*
- 2 – *You cannot be in true fellowship with God and out of fellowship with other believers.*
- 3 – *Koinonia takes on new dimensions, new possibilities, and new richness as churches relate in the wider circles of the kingdom.*
- 4 – *Koinonia with God is an experience of His Presence.*
- 5 – *Only a personal encounter with the living Christ will result in effective Koinonia.*

Principles

- Every congregation is a world-missions strategy center.
- We considered everything each of us possessed as belonging by love to one another
- Sharing developed a deep sense of *koinonia* among our churches.
- Essentials of *Koinonia*: 1. We must love God with our total being. 2. We must submit to God's sovereign rule. 3. We must experience God in a real and personal way. 4. We must completely trust in God.
- Every member of the church must submit to Christ's lordship over his life and to Christ's headship over the church.

- 2 – A church is a vital, living, dynamic fellowship of believers.
- 2– *Koinonia* is the fullest possible partnership and fellowship with God and with others.
- 2 – I cannot be in true fellowship with God and out of fellowship with other believers.
