Daily Capstones

Principles

- Once couples came to understand God's purpose for their marriages, they discovered a new and exciting dimension to their lives together.
- God's eternal purpose for each of your children is that they be conformed to the image of Christ.
- I wanted my kids to learn to put their trust in God, not in their parents.
- Church on Sunday provides an opportunity for the saints to be equipped for their mission work throughout the week at their job sites.
- I believe churches ought to have commissioning services for those who go into the marketplace every Monday morning in the same way we pray over missionaries who travel to other countries to share the gospel.
- There are no substitutes for obedience.
